

## ISSF ProActive Vessel Register Delisting and Relisting Procedure

Version 1 October 31, 2019

## Delisting a Vessel on the PVR:

If a large-scale purse seine vessel has not demonstrated to be in compliance with ISSF Conservation Measure (CM) <u>7.2</u>, any and all large-scale purse seine vessels owned by the same business organization will not be eligible to be listed on the Record. If those vessels are already on the Record, they will be removed. The delisted vessels will be added to a list that is posted on the ISSF website and maintained by MRAG Americas. A 'screen shot' of the vessel(s) will also be posted on the website that includes the status of the vessel at time of delisting. ISSF will notify the Implementation Team and Board members at the time of delisting.

## **Relisting of a Vessel back in Compliance:**

If a vessel, and the entire fleet owned by the same business organization, becomes compliant with CM 7.2, MRAG Americas will remove the vessel(s), and/or fleet, from the PDF Summary of Delisted Vessels, along with the 'screen shots' of the vessel(s) history. MRAG Americas will immediately notify the ISSF PVR Administrator to ensure full compliance is reflected both on the PVR and Record of Large-Scale Purse Seines. The Implementation Team and ISSF Board members will be notified at the time of relisting.
